This stance is in line with regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2017, laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

As part of this legislation, we are in contact with our suppliers to confirm their responsible handling of material sourcing/manufacturing.

Based on this statement and the information received from our suppliers, we hereby confirm our due diligence.
